- 1) The transition period is extended for accredited labs from 31/12/2023 to 31/08/2024 (12 months to 20 months).
- 2) Accredited labs:
  - a. May apply for renewal of accreditation with the previous legal identity.
  - b. If there will be an adverse action as per NABL 216, then those labs will be treated as fresh/new lab when they are reapplying for accreditation.
  - c. If there will be any change in the name or transfer, then it will be treated as fresh/new lab.
  - d. If the lab has not submitted the renewal application before expiry, then it will be treated as fresh/new lab when they are reapplying for accreditation.

Note: All fresh/new labs will not be accepted with previous legal identity, like proprietorship & partnership.
